

LOGISTICS AND RESOURCES

**VENUE** 

An ISO-certified fully equipped equestrian club with indoor and outdoor facilities and friendly environment

EQUIP MENT

Supplies for painting, horse feeding, and interacting with horses

#### SAFETY PROTOCOLS:

All employees will receive comprehensive training on safety protocols, including procedures for handling horses, assisting children during activities, and responding to emergencies.

#### 2 HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS:

Detailed health records of participating children, including any allergies or medical conditions, will be collected in advance.

Medical professionals will be onsite to provide assistance if needed.

#### **3** HORSE HANDLING:

Trained professionals will oversee all interactions between children and horses to ensure the safety of both parties. Children will receive instructions on proper behavior around horses, including maintaining a safe distance and approaching them calmly. Additionally, horses with a gentle temperament and experience with children will be selected for the event to minimize the risk of accidents.

## 4 INCIDENT RESPONSE PLAN

First aid kits and emergency contact information will be readily accessible onsite, and trained staff will follow established protocols for handling emergencies

# EVALUATION AND SUCCESS METRICS



## PARTICIPANTS ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend the awareness session on Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and strategies for interacting with autistic children to understand how to deal with children effectively.
- Greet the children and get acquainted with them by understanding their preferences and sensitivities.
- Walk them through the guided tour of the stables to meet the horses and learn about their care.
- Encourage children to interact with the horses and feed them.
- Paint on the horses with the children creating a fun atmosphere.
- Assist the children during pony rides by walking alongside, providing support, and encouraging them.
